

2020 Legislative Priorities

Children's Campaign Fund believes that the top priority of our state is the health and well-being of Washington's kids. While Washington is one of the wealthiest states in the country, many of our children and families face significant challenges that prevent them from sharing in our state's prosperity. The Legislature has supported policies to address these significant challenges but oftentimes the scale of policy is insufficient and the access to programs is uneven.

In the 2020 legislative session, CCF asks members to champion all Washington's children by expanding access to the following:

Health Care

Expand access to mental health treatment, substance abuse treatment and dental therapy.

Early Learning

Expand access to high quality early learning opportunities.

Childcare

Expand access to quality, affordable childcare so all Washington families have the resources they need to succeed.

Housing

Expand access to stable housing to Washington's homeless youth and families facing housing insecurity.

Education

Expand access to equitable and appropriate educational opportunities for all children including those with special needs.

CCF looks forward to the 2020 Legislative Session and stands ready to support legislation that extends opportunity, security and support to all Washington's children.
